






SHOPPING

THE LEGENDARY ROGUE RIVER IS YOUR FRIEND IN ADVENTURE.

The Roque River has attracted visitors of all ages from all over the world to experience it's pristine beauty and enjoy the unique recreational offerings, including rafting, fishing, jet boating, and floating. If you ask a local about what to do on the river, you likely engage in a long, thoughtful conversation. The people of Grants Pass are passionate about the river, as it is such an important part of their lives.

The Roque stretches 215 miles from Crater Lake to the Pacific Ocean with the heart of this iconic river running right through the center of Grants Pass. It is also among the most beautiful and scenic waterways in the country, prompting Congress to designate 84 miles of it naturally "Wild and Scenic". Just 7 miles downriver from Grants Pass you enter an epic stretch where some of the most breathtaking views await along with an abundance of wildlife. Bald eagles, black bears, river otters, ospreys, black-tail deer, and great blue heron can all be spotted along the river's banks.

The Rogue River is also home to many expert guides who will outfit your group for a safe, spectacular adventure. Whether you have an interest in fishing, rafting, or touring the Rogue River on a jet boat, you're sure to create memories of a lifetime.

FISHING





The Applegate Valley is known for both its farm and wine country. Explore wineries serving a variety of wines, from bold







ILLINOIS VALLEY

You'll love the refreshing swimming spots as well as the chance to raft or fish in one of Oregon's most tranquil settings.











TASTE THE BOUNTY OF OUR COUNTY








ART ALONG THE ROGUE
