- 1 Take a thrilling ride on the Rogue River with HellgateJetboat Excursions
- 2 Pick out fresh produce and handmade treats at the Grants Pass Growers Market, Cave Junction Market, and the Applegate Evening Market
- 3 Visit The Glass Forge to see their glass work gallery and catch a glass-blowing demonstration or try it yourself
- 4 Learn about the history of Grants Pass and Josephine County at the Schmidt House Museum
- 5 Catch a show at the historic Rogue Theatre
- 6 See and learn about animal rehabilitation at Wildlife Images Rehabilitation and Education Center
- 7 Take an adventure along the Applegate Wine Trail
- 8 Take in the artwork at the Grants Pass Museum of Art

- 9 Shop the unique stores downtown for products you can't find elsewhere; stop by Fiona Bean, Gallop N' Glitz, Loam + Black, Shoefly, and many more!
- 10 Raft the Rogue River Wild & Scenic Lower Section with one of our many experienced guides and outfitters
- 11 Sample some delicious cheese at the Rogue Creamery Dairy and Farm Stand after learning about the milking robots on the dairy tour
- 12 View the Illinois River's unique Darlingtonia plants along the Eight Dollar Mountain Botanical Wayside
- 13 Backpack to the coast or plan a day hike along the Rogue River National Recreation Trail
- 14 Get your favorite coffee, smoothie, or tea from the Dutch Bros' Coffee House, where Dutch Bros originally started as a coffee cart
- 15 Grab some lunch, scratch made bakes goods, and homemade jam at Pennington Farms
- 16 Admire the sea of purple at the Lavender Fields in late June through mid-July along the Southern Oregon Lavendar Trail
- 17 For those in search of a nostalgic 1950s experience, try Grants Pass Pharmacy's delicious milkshakes and phosphate sodas
- 18 Follow the smell of popcorn to the historic Blind George's Popcorn News Stand at Sandi's Candies & Fudgery
- 19 Take a stroll downtown and follow the Public Art Walking Map or the Historic Downtown Walking Map; pick up your maps at the Downtown Welcome Center
- 20 Book a boat tour of Crater Lake, the deepest lake in the United States
- 21 Take a ranger-guided cave tour at the Oregon
 Caves National Monument

- 22 Compete in a friendly game of Pickleball at
 Reinhart Volunteer Park, then grab a smoothie at
 True Juice Organics
- 23 Escape reality during a thrilling Murder Mystery
 Dinner Theater at Cynthia's Home Sweet Home
- 24 Sample craft brews at one of our local breweries; check out Weekend Beer Company, Wild River Brewing and Pizza Co, Climate City Brewing Co, or The Haul
- 25 Tee off at one of our beautiful Golf Courses. Choose between Grants Pass Golf Club, Dutcher Creek Golf Course, Applegate River Golf Club, and many more
- 26 Choose an easy, moderate, or more challenging trail to hike or mountain bike ride at Cathedral HillsTrails System
- 27 Enjoy a meal with a beautiful view at one of our river-side restaurants, such as Taprock Northwest Grill and Rivers Edge Restaurant.
- 28 See the Rogue's deepest river gorge at Hellgate Canyon Overlook, a popular Hollywood film site
- 29 Browse through the numerous antique stores downtown, such as Elegance Antiques, Old Town Antique Mall, and Rusty Nugget Antiques
- 30 Enjoy some of the many locally made spirits Grants Pass has to offer; stop by Steam Distillery or Sundance Distilling
- 31 Experience fun, music, art, food, shopping, and deals during Alive at Five on the first Friday of each month, March through December
- 32 Play disc golf with a friend at Tom Pearce CountyPark or Riverside Park
- 33 Book a tour of the Evergreen's Bear Hotel that houses our Bearfest Bears, a Southern Oregon Experience to walk through. During the holidays, enjoy the magic of Christmas with Rogue Winterfest.

- 34 Spend a night or two in a treehouse at one of our Treesorts, Out-N-About Treehouse Treesort or Vertical Horizons Treehouse Paradise
- 35 Shop for one-of-a-kind locally made art pieces at the Southern Oregon Guild in Kerby
- 36 Stop by the Racing on the Rogue in June & July to view the only horse racing in Oregon at Grants Pass Downs
- 37 Take the family swimming at the Caveman Pool
- 38 Cruise over to the Redwood National and State
 Parks and be amazed by the towering trees
- 39 Stay in the same room as Walt Disney, Clarke Gable, and other Hollywood favorites at Weasku Inn
- 40 Pitch a tent or bring your RV to camp at one of the picturesque Josephine County Parks
- 41 Check out the tremendous sculptures and tree houses at It's a Burl Gallery
- 42 Develop a deeper appreciation for nature by taking a workshop at Pacifica: A Garden in the Siskiyous or Siskiyou Field Institute
- 43 Practice your fly casting at the Reinhart Volunteer Park Pond, then take a guided fishing experience along the Rogue River
- 44 Listen to free live music and dance while atConcerts in the Park
- 45 Watch chalk artists work and see fantastic art at Art Along the Rogue, the premier street painting and music festival in the Northwest, the first weekend of October
- 46 Catch a concert downtown at The Hivve, Rogue Theatre, or The Haul

- 48 Explore Golden Ghost Town and learn about its rich history
- 49 Experience the 'Home of Oregon's memories' at the Pottsville Oregon Historic Museum
